KOMODO NATIONAL PARK

Just a short flight from the beaches of Bali, Komodo National Park is a place of truly diverse natural beauty and incredible wildlife. Offering signature pink-sand beaches and some of the world's best diving, it's a destination that won't disappoint.

Teeming with sea life, Komodo National Park's plentiful coral reefs are considered some of the best in all of Indonesia. Dolphins and manta rays are common sightings, and the area is also on a whale migration route.

The grassy sloped islands that make up the park offer visitors gentle trekking trails and beautiful beaches to relax on, as well as the opportunity to see the famous Komodo dragons, the largest living lizards on the planet.

This 10-night itinerary in Komodo aboard the luxurious *Lamima*, the world's largest wooden sailing yacht, is an extraordinary glimpse into Indonesia.



DAY 1: GILI LAWA LAUT

On arrival at the airport, our crew will transfer you to *Lamima*. During lunch, the yacht will set sail for Gili Lawa Laut. There we will anchor in a secluded bay with stunning scenery close to some of the most exciting dive sites in Indonesia.

These waters are teeming with incredible marine life. Dive or snorkel with schools of fish including trevally, groupers, sweetlips, barracudas, and white tip reef sharks. In the afternoon, enjoy a hike to a spectacular viewpoint with *Lamima* anchored in the bay.

For any afternoon arrivals, the yacht will sail to a nearby island called Papangga instead of Gili Lawa Laut. Spend this afternoon enjoying watersports or easing into a leisurely Indonesian pace on deck.

DAY 2: MT. SANGEANG ISLAND

Sangeang is an active volcano with amazing topography. Reefs are excellent here with good visibility and volcanic black sand among colorful soft and hard corals and different types of anemones. Dive on Hot Rock Reef on the active volcano, surrounded by harmless, incredible sulfur bubbles from a natural underwater vent. Enjoy the option of a beautiful hike in the afternoon inside a canyon.



DAY 3: MOYO ISLAND

This island has a beautiful dive site with plenty of marine life and a healthy reef. In the afternoon, after a short ride, visit a lovely local village en-route to a stunning river with a multi-terraced waterfall. Enjoy a bit of time for a swim and relaxation in a natural bath.

DAY 4: SALEH BAY

Teluk Saleh has attracted recent attention as whale sharks have been spotted in the bay and remained in the area. With the help of a local guide, we find the best time to swim among these gentle giants.

DAY 5: SATONDA

Satonda Island was formed with the eruption of Mt. Tambora, the second largest volcano eruption ever recorded. The surrounding beaches in Satonda are perfect for spending the afternoon snorkeling and paddleboarding. This is also an ideal area to see pygmy seahorses and a wide variety of marine life.





DAY 6: TORO MABALANG

This beautiful white sand beach looks slightly pink due to the red coral in the area. This sheltered bay is the perfect spot to enjoy watersports, beachcombing, and a nighttime barbecue. Snorkelers and divers will enjoy the beautiful waters and colorful corals. At sunset, go for a stroll above the beach to admire the anchorage with *Lamima* and the volcano in the background.

DAY 7: GILI BANTA

Today's calling point is the perfect spot for a relaxed day of walks on the long, white sand beach. Or perhaps enjoy some watersports in a sheltered bay surrounded by beautiful scenery, as jet skiing is allowed in this area. With its hard coral gardens, this is a great place for shallow and drift diving with the possibility of swimming with manta rays.

DAY 8: TORO MONCO

During an early cruise to North Komodo, stop on Teluk Boko to spot Komodo dragons on the beach; these animals are the largest living lizard on earth and can weigh up to 300 pounds.

Then continue the journey as *Lamima* drops anchor in front of Toro Monco, a beautiful white sandy beach sheltered in a majestic bay in the Northwest of the Komodo National Park. It is an excellent diving spot and perfect for watersports.





DAY 9: SOUTH RINCA AND PADAR

In the morning, sail to South Rinca, one of the region's best dive sites, and experience the best of what Komodo National Park has to offer. Swim with nudibranch, turtles, sea snakes and frogfish among some of the most colorful corals in Indonesia. Before lunch, tender to shore for another opportunity view Komodo dragons.

During lunch, the yacht moves to Padar Island to hike the iconic islands of Komodo National Park. After an afternoon of watersports, enjoy a sunset hike to see the three majestic bays.

DAY 10: BIDADARI

Early in the day, *Lamima* will cruise to Tatawa Besar. This is a great opportunity to see many turtles while diving or snorkeling. After lunch, *Lamima's* crew will hoist all the sails and cruise towards Bidadari for an afternoon of watersports.

DAY 11: LABUAN BAJO

After brunch, the yacht will move to Labuan Bajo where the crew will transfer you back to the airport for your onward journey.

ABOUT LAMIMA

Lamima is the epitome of luxury from topsail to keel. She has been custom built with the specific intent of providing the ultimate in comfort, elegance, and safety while maintaining the warm ambiance of traditional Indonesian hospitality. Designed in 2012 by esteemed yacht designer Marcelo Penna, she offers a massive 400 sqm of the open deck on a total of 900 sqm of usable space. Marcelo has also given her an impressive sail wardrobe designed to catch every breeze of the archipelago, thus creating a first-class sailing vessel with all the opulence of a superyacht.

The construction of *Lamima* was entrusted to the skillful traditional boat builders of Ara, Sulawesi. In crafting the vessel, they succeeded in combining the authenticity and charm of the Indonesian two-masted trading ship of yore (the Phinisi) with the latest concepts in yacht design and technology –producing an exceptional vessel with a distinguished pedigree.





EQUIPMENT & CAPABILITIES

Lamima's impressive suite of onboard equipment ensures we make the most of every opportunity above and below the water line. Experience the exhilarating speed of a wakeboard towed behind the yacht's 10m RIB tender, enjoy a sunset from a stand-up paddleboard, or drift slowly along in a Jukung (Indonesian canoes). Whether leisurely snorkeling in a lagoon or speeding away on a jet ski, every item of watersport equipment aboard *Lamima* meets the most stringent safety regulations.

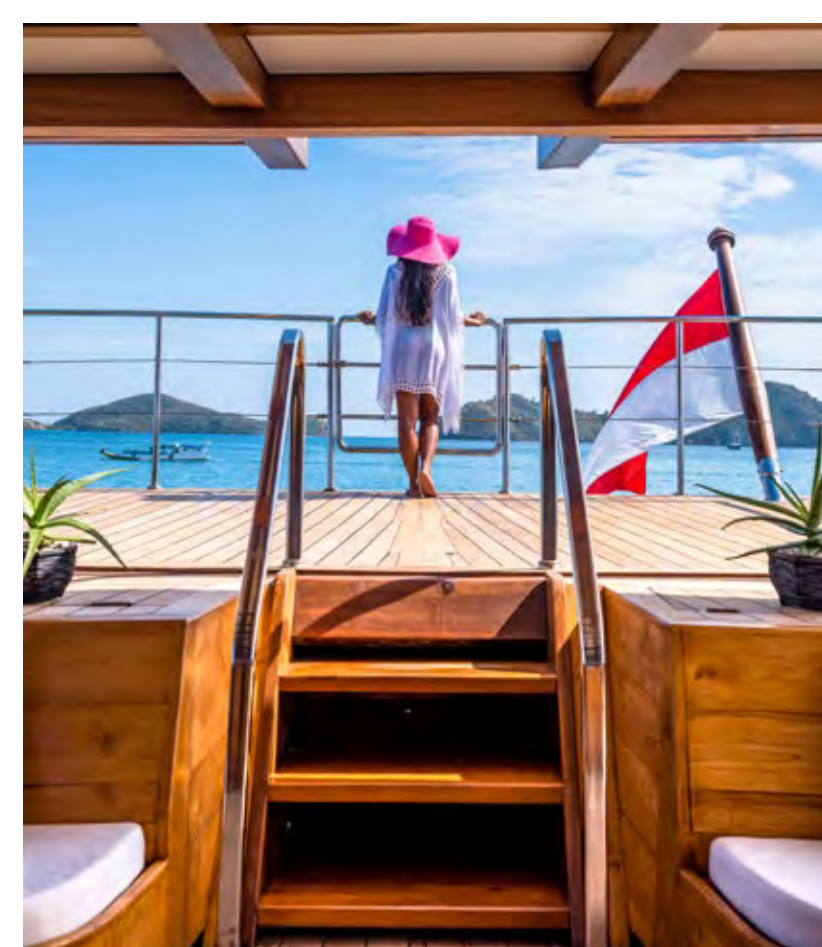

LUXURY AND COMFORT

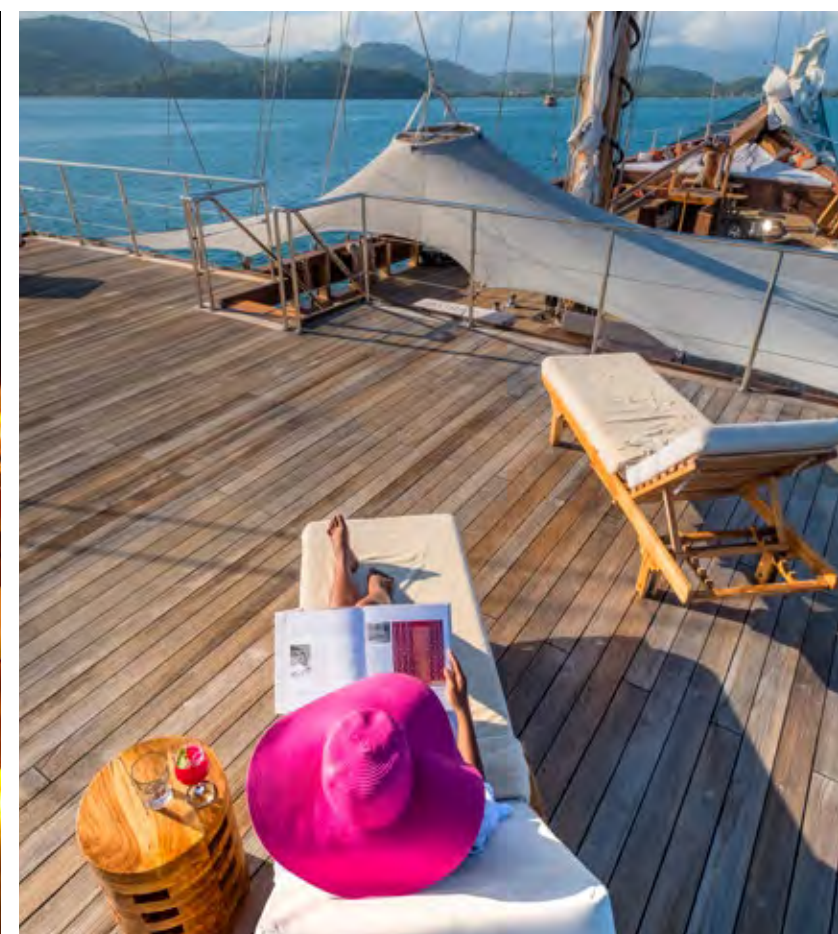
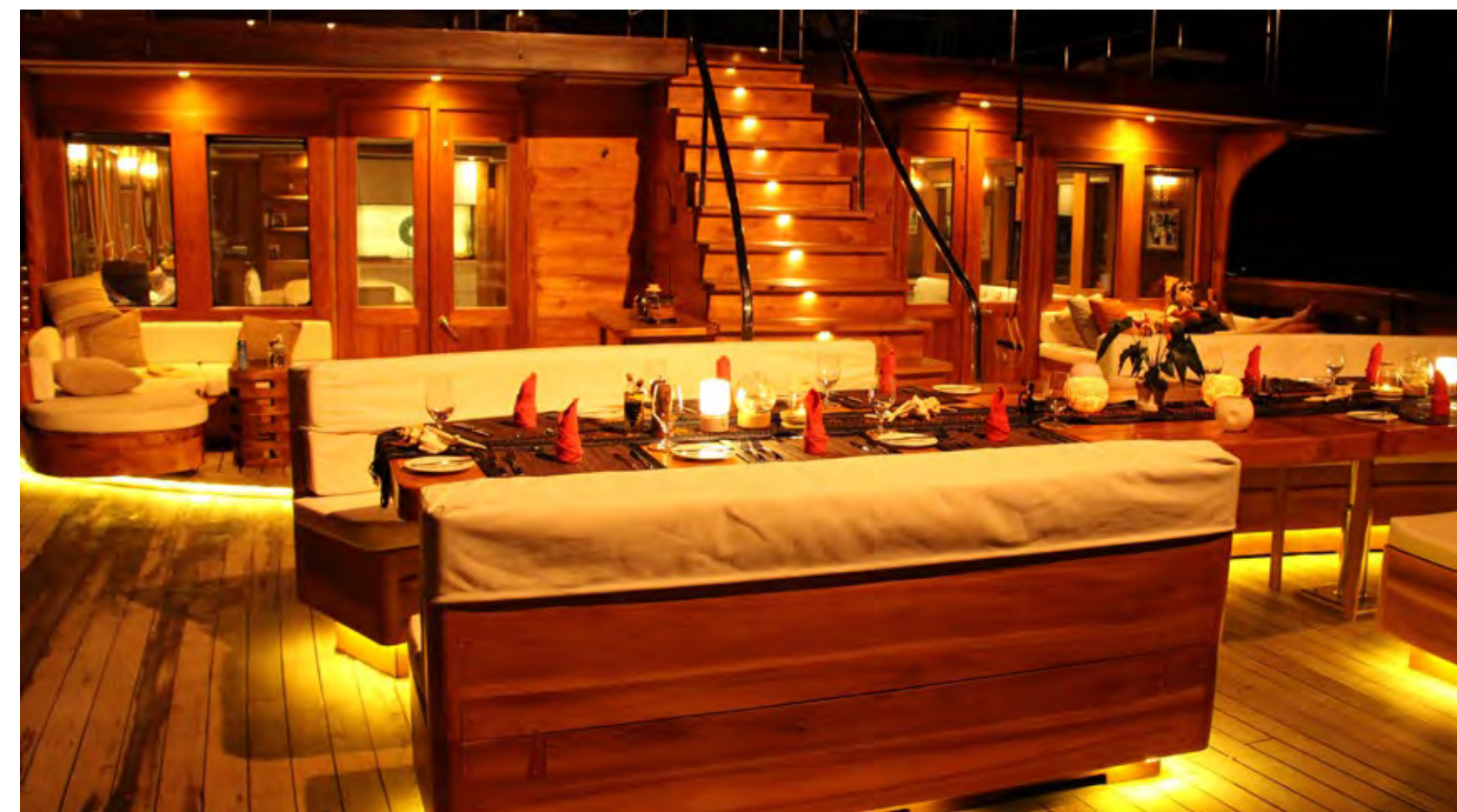
Lamima's interior, warmly inviting with an understated contemporary Asian influence, has been specifically designed to accommodate 14 guests in extraordinary comfort.

Lamima's saloon is situated midship on the main deck. This spacious area is furnished with a bar and lounge as well as a vast dining table designed to comfortably seat fourteen people.

Forward of the saloon, shaded by a fabric Bimini, a large area has been custom designed for al fresco dining and lounging. The seats and the dining table can convert to large sun pads to make full use of this shaded area. Whether under sail or at anchor under the stars, it serves as the center for communal life aboard *Lamima*, the place to come together and make plans for the next adventure ashore.

The stern section of this same deck has been designated as *Lamima's* 'relaxation quarter'. Here, in total privacy, the expert hands of our qualified Pijat masseuses soothe you after a day spent enjoying watersports or onboard activities. Guests can enjoy different spa treatments and massages throughout the day.

The upper deck extending forward of the pilot house is furnished with Indonesian sun mattresses and dedicated to relaxation. Turn the pages of a novel, rest, or enjoy a chat with friends.





ACCOMMODATIONS

Each of the 7 spacious and elegant cabins, furnished around a central theme of relaxed luxury with an undertone of Indonesian tradition, has a luxurious ensuite bathroom, comfortable seating, and ample storage for personal belongings.

Internet service is available in every cabin as well as HD TV, iPod docking stations, and an extensive movie library.

COSTS INCLUDED:

All accommodations aboard the vessel; all meals, non-alcoholic beverages, and standard alcoholic beverages aboard the vessel from lunch on Sept 1 through breakfast on Sept 11; scuba diving from the vessel, shore excursions; access fees and special access permits; use of the vessel's kayaks and tenders; transfers between the airport and the vessel on Sept 1 and Sept 11; personal laundry onboard; taxes and service charges; internet service (note: internet service may be unstable at times due technical challenges caused by the location of the vessel and/or technical issues by the service provider); services of the dive master and expedition staff.

COSTS NOT INCLUDED:

Air transportation; passport, visa and immigration fees; meals not indicated; travel protection plan; top shelf alcoholic beverages and items of a personal nature such as satellite phone calls. Gratuities to ship's crew and the expedition staff are at your discretion.

AIRFARE:

Airfare to and from your home to Indonesia is not included.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

RESERVATIONS:

To reserve your place, an advance payment of 50% of the voyage price is required. The advance payment must be paid within seven (7) days of receiving the invoice for the reservation. Payment must be made by wire transfer to the account on the invoice. Your initial payment indicates your acceptance of our complete Terms and Conditions. We require written notice at the time of reservation of any physical conditions, diet or treatment requiring special attention.

FINAL PAYMENT:

Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure. If final payment is not received on time, confirmed reservations will be canceled, with rebooking subject to space availability.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We strongly recommend that you purchase travel and cancellation insurance, including medical evacuation coverage, to protect your investment in the event of unexpected or unforeseen circumstances.

SMOKING POLICY:

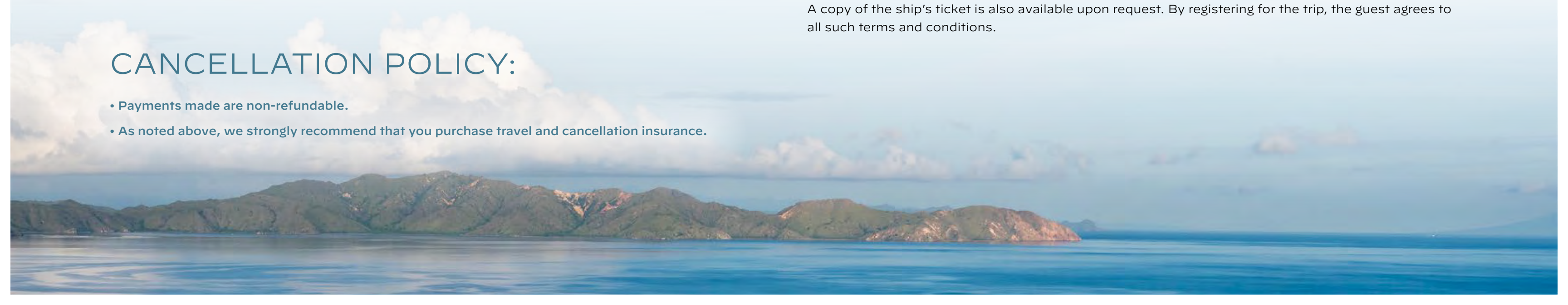
Smoking is allowed only in the designated outdoor areas.
